



Qualcomm Million Dollar Challenge Change Gears. Change Lives.

On October 18 through October 24, 2008, 100 cyclists will ride 600 miles down the California coastline, from San Francisco to San Diego. The goal is to raise over \$1 million for the Challenged Athletes Foundation - a unique organization that enables people with physical challenges to participate and compete in the sports the rest of us take for granted.

Each day of the ride the participants will cycle 56 to 114 miles across (and over!) some of the most scenic – and demanding – terrain in California. During the Million Dollar Challenge, participants will ride alongside athletes who may be missing an arm or leg ... who are paralyzed and utilizing a handcycle to cover the miles ... or who are vision-impaired and are riding tandem with a guide who serves as their “eyes.” Together, they will deliver a message that will reverberate across California – and across our nation: people with physical challenges can be athletes, too and all that’s standing in the way of their dreams is a chronic and pervasive lack of funding.

Entry is limited to 100 cyclists who each raise \$10,000 for CAF and in return will enjoy a fully supported ride.
