Have you ever wondered what it is like to be on a world famous race track in a world famous sports car? Wonder no more NCCA is going to the track and you can drive your car or ride as a passenger in another member's Corvette.

For a number of years NCCA members have “tracked” their Corvettes. It is an exciting experience to see what these fabulously engineered cars are able to do. We are going to give all our members a chance to experience this by riding along with those of us who have experience on this track.

There are **2 options** for those of you that have not tracked:

1—You can sign up for **Driving School** that day and get a very good introduction to the track in your own Corvette (must be a coup, No convertibles). The organizer will put you through a class room then take you out on the track where you will follow instructors (who could be some other NCCA member) at a slow pace to learn how you drive the track at slow speed which will then be followed by more classroom then more track time, stepping up the speed as you progress.

2—If you just want to see what it is like, come ride as a passenger with a regular NCCA tracker .You will get to see what a Corvette can do and know what the track is like the next time you watch a professional race at Laguna.

For option 1 go to: <http://www.ncracing.org/> and sign up for Driving School on January 30. For option 2 just go with us to Laguna. If you have a helmet bring it. If not, we will bring extra helmets.

It will be an early day as we will need to be at the track by 7:45 in the morning. You could go Friday night and stay at a hotel in Salinas or Monterey both of which are about 15 minutes from the track. We can make recommendations for that. Otherwise figure 2 hours from either the San Mateo or Castro Valley area. The day will end around 4:00pm after which we will find a place for a beer and some food and talk about the experience. **RSVP to and ask any questions to one of the below.**
